### CHINESE MINISTRY

December 2017

Dear Friends,

Thanks to your prayers and support, God continues to provide opportunities to grow our Chinese ministry of sharing the Gospel.

In mid-November, I had an opportunity to interview Al Plantinga (who was awarded the 2017 Templeton Prize) and seven famous contemporary Christian scholars, including Richard Mouw, Nicholas Wolterstorff, George Marsden, Philip Holtrop, John Cooper, and Emily Brink in Grand Rapids, MI. I was greatly impressed by their humility, their respect for different views, and their commitment to the church. In addition, as a group of Christian intellectuals, they are like iron sharpening iron, and strive to "live together in unity" (Psalm 133). There is much we can learn from these Christian Intellectuals.

Coming back to Chicago, we committed to making these interviews into eight videos, and get the contents published in China too. The goal is to introduce the thoughts these great thinkers and the Reformed theology behind them. I believe that this will positively inspire the Chinese church especially in such changing times. To me, it is just amazing to realize that although Grand Rapids is a smaller city, it has extremely rich spiritual resources.

As you may know, the BTGMI Board of Directors decided that the agency will be relocated from the southern suburbs of Chicago to the headquarters of the CRCNA in Grand Rapids by July of next year. In light of that decision, these interviews have given me inspiration for the future development of Chinese ministry. While vigorously developing indigenous ministry in China, we should also vigorously connect the valuable resources of the American churches to the Chinese churches. I believe this is the role God wants the Chinese ministry of BTGMI to take.

We realize this move has created big changes and challenges, as many of our co-workers will not be able to move to Grand Rapids. As for my family and I, we relocated from Los Angeles to Chicago less than four years ago, and now we will relocate again. Please remember us in your prayers. May God bless the staff who are affected, leading them to what God has planned for

them next. May God give us the faith of Abraham, a faith that will surely grow with the years we serve him.

The 2017 Chinese Annual Ministry Report follows this letter. It will give you a clearer picture of how God has blessed the Chinese ministry. Thank you for your faithful support.

### COMMEMORATE THE 500TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE REFORMATION

- ·《一個帖子引發的持續500年的革命》:製作5分鐘動畫短片,輕鬆幽默,有國、粵、英、西四版,觀看已經超過20萬次。
- · A Post That Led to a Reformation: We produced a 5-minute motion graphics video; light-hearted and humorous. We now have Mandarin, Cantonese, English, and Spanish versions. Viewership is more than 200,000 now and contiunes to grow.
- ·《承傳與反思》:製作20分鐘視頻,訪談11位中國牧者與學者及領袖們,探討反思當代處境下中國教會的發展方向。
- · Heritage and Reflection: A production of a 20-minute interview with Chinese pastors, scholars, and leaders who share their reflection on the Reformation and how it could make an impact on today's Chinese church. Spoken in Mandarin, with Chinese and English captions.

- · 4月,在美國密西根州大溪城舉辦主辦文字及出版事工研討會,20餘位來自中國、臺灣、北美等地的牧者、學者和基督徒出版人和媒體人參加。
- · 11月,參加在泰國曼谷舉辦的500人專題研討大會,並為大會提供深度 報導。
- · In April, we hosted a publishing and communication symposium in Grand Rapids, MI. More than 20 pastors, scholars, and publishers participated. Attendees came from Mainland China, Taiwan, and North America.
- · In November, we attended a mission conference hosted in Bangkok, Thailand with 500 participants. We also produced an in-depth newscast through our new media platform.











- · 3月,在台北主辦第五屆話語論壇 ,來自台灣、中國、香港300多媒体 宣教人士参加,會後出版並發布《走進公共,深入處境:新媒體時代基督 教傳播策略指引》。
- · In March, we hosted the 5th Word Symposium in Taiwan. About 300 media missionaries from Taiwan, mainland China, Hong Kong, and North America attended. After the event, we released a booklet titled **Strategies and Guidelines for Christian Media Ministry in a New Media Era.**



# 持續推動新媒體宣教

### CONTINUE TO PROMOTE NEW MEDIA MISSION

- · 6月,組織帶領40多位北美教會牧者同工,參觀位於奧克拉荷馬州的 Life.Church,會後出版《新媒體教案例學習》一書,為教會未來發展提 供參照。
- · 9月,完成並發布《2017年基督徒微信公眾號影響力報告》,為中國新媒體事工發展提供準確深入的資料分析和發展指導。
- ·編寫錄製《網路宣教視頻培訓課程》,共十二課,2017年底完成,並在各地華人教會及神學院推廣。
- · In June, we organized a tour of about 40 church leaders to Life. Church of Oklahoma City, OK. After the event, we published a case-study book named **Being Church**, **Being Media**, providing powerful references to church development.
- · In September, we released a big data research report titled A Media Impact Study on Wechat Christian Contents in 2017, providing accurate and in-depth data and direction for the New Media mission.
- · We are in process of creating a video project, **Internet Mission Curriculum**, which consists of twelve topics. It is scheduled to be finished by the end of 2017 and will be promoted to Chinese churches and seminaries.

- · We launched a WeChat mini program called **Bible for Today**: an organic platform for our three major productions: Be Thou My Rhythm, Chinese Today devotional, and an online Bible. The goal is to nurture the spiritual growth of Christians.
- · We selected articles from **Be Thou My Rhythm** and made an audio version, which was the forefront of our Chinese ministry in the past. We hope to resume this to provide a multimedia service to our audience.
