Virtual Learning

It has been a long 5 months of teaching via distant learning, yet I am amazed at what we have been able to accomplish in those 5 months. Our teachers continue to teach via Zoom calls and posting assignments on Google Classroom. For the last two months we have worked hard to promote Reading. Within each grade level students have been broken into smaller groups based on their level and teachers have been working to help every student grow in this area.

The government and educational leaders of the country are in the process of opening schools again for in-person learning based on COVID numbers. Forty-eight municipals have been given the green light to start back up in-person. Unfortunately, Santiago (where our school is located) isn't allowed to open just yet because of the percentage of COVID cases still present in that region. Lord willing our current plan is to finish this school year remotely, doing our best to help each student succeed, and then start fresh next school year. We praise God for His faithfulness to us and for his continued help on this crazy journey.

Parent-teacher conferences

God has been good to us by providing parents who for the most part have been supportive throughout this whole process. We held in-person parent-teacher conferences at the end of March with several goals in mind. First, we wanted to have a personal connection with the parents to show them directly our interest in helping their child succeed, while at the same time provide the support they need. Second, we took the opportunity to share the progress of the students with their parents, highlighting strengths and positive aspects, and communicating areas that could improve. Finally, it gave us the opportunity to share the message of hope, reminding them that Jesus is our hope and explaining why we celebrate Holy Week (Easter) which happened to fall the week after conferences. Out of 247 students, only thirteen parents didn't show up to participate in their child's conference. Praise God for that!

COVID Vaccinations

We praise God that he provided our staff the opportunity to receive the COVID vaccination. On March 18, they received the first dose. We hope they will be able to receive the second dose soon.

Special Celebrations

Independence Day – Independence Day in the Dominican Republic is celebrated on February 27. As a school our students always participate in a special program, and even a parade around the community. Because of COVID and remote learning our students weren't able to participate in a program this year. So, our staff organized a program where they presented different aspects that should be remembered and celebrated about this special day. They recorded the program and sent it to all the students. It is great to see our whole staff get involved in the education of our students.

International Women's Day – On March 8, we celebrated the 21 special women that are a part of our staff. They were presented with a special gift and were given a buffet breakfast as well. The three men that are on staff organized the reading of some poems, scriptures, and said a prayer of gratitude for these ladies. We praise God for our whole staff and for how God continues to use each one of them to minister at Pathway to Jesus.
