When the team came back this past January, they shared photos of the children at the orphanage and the school grounds where they attend. Upon seeing these photos and speaking with a member of the traveling group that went to the orphanage, we noticed a dirt field which they use for soccer practice. The children at the orphanage would love to have a new soccer field to improve their grounds and give them lots of great exercise. The staff at Orland Park Christian Preschool decided to support the building of a soccer field for the orphanage in Honduras with the funds that would be collected at our annual Preschool Trike-a-thon.

The preschool children learned that by riding their bikes around a track in the church parking lot and asking their family members to support them, they would be able to bring money to school that could be used to help build a soccer field for the children at the orphanage. What a great opportunity to teach these young preschoolers about giving to others that are in need and being a blessing to them!

When the days for our Trike-a-thons finally arrived, all the preschool children were very excited for the event! They decorated their trikes and bikes with name plate crafts that they made. We all gathered under the church canopy when we got outside and many parents, grandparents, and friends joined us. Kellie Loerop from His Heart and Hands Orphan Ministry was there to thank us and lead us in a prayer for safety and for blessings for the children at Hogar de Amor orphanage. She also brought a photo album of her recent visit to Honduras to share photos of the children at the orphanage. We lined up our bikes at the starting line on the church parking lot, took some

pictures, and when the whistle sounded we took off! We rode around the track for approximately 10 minutes. Our teachers counted the number of laps that each child rode. Our supporters stood around the outside of the track and cheered for the children. What fun it was to do something



we really enjoy and serve others at the same time! We are so blessed and we are thankful that we can be a blessing too.



PRESCHOOL EMBRYOLOGY STUDY

Early in April, the children at Orland Park Christian Preschool spent a week learning about God's wonderful plan for growing baby chicks inside of eggs. This is a miracle that only God can do! Instead of going to the farm to see the mother hens sitting on their eggs, we were given the opportunity to keep some chicken eggs in our school incubator. We learned that it is very important for the eggs to be kept warm and for them to be turned regularly. While we waited, we looked at books and photos of baby chicks developing inside the eggs.

After 21 days of counting down and waiting, (and a few extra days of waiting this year), the preschool



children were treated to the hatching of baby chicks in the incubator. They were able to observe live births, freshly-hatched chicks that needed to rest, and the change that occurs in just a few hours from a newborn chick that is wet and wobbly to a fluffy yellow chick that is ready to move to a brooder box.
